Came to the United States in 1888 and until 1893 was engaged in accounting work in the southern states; then became affiliated with the accounting department of the Lehigh Valley Railroad Company in Philadelphia, of which company he became general bookkeeper. In 1901 Mr. Forsdick became associated with Haskins and Sells, certified public accountants in New York, with whom he remained for ten years. He became Associate at Large of the American Association of Public Accountants and a member of the Institute of Accounts, and was for four years a member of the faculty of the New York University School of Commerce, Accounts and Finance. Mr. Forsdick has been a persistent investigator in the field of accountancy, and has travelled extensively, both in the United States and Europe. He is a progressive exponent of practical applied accounting and organization in their relation...
